Château Tasting notes (December 2014)

• Quality: ★★★★★ (mythic)

• Color: beautiful deep red

Nose: fruity with dominating notes of black fruits

• Palate: gorgeous structure with a long finish

Characteristics of vintage

- Weather: a beautiful summer followed by an absolutely perfect autumn. The wet winter favoured the reconstitution of the water-table. Agreeable spring, despite frequent storms. The superb hot and dry summer lasted especially to mid-October.
- Harvest: the picking began with Merlot on September 23rd and finished with the Cabernet-Sauvignon on October 9th.

Blending of vintage 2009

- 50% Cabernet-Sauvignon
- 40% Merlot
- 10% Cabernet-Franc

Serving suggestions

Aging potential: drink or hold for a few years

• Serving temperature: between 16°C (60.4°F) and 18°C (64.4°F)

Decanting time: serve directly from the bottle
